- 5. Presentation of trophies, followed by the Raffle Draw, will take place in the Cookery & Craft Tent at 4.00 p.m. prompt.
- 6. Allocation of prize money on production of prize-winning cards at 4.15 p.m.
- 7. All goods must be collected between 4.30 p.m. and 4.45 p.m. as Stewards will NOT be on duty after this time.
- 8. The Judges' decision is final and they are empowered to withhold prizes when exhibits are considered unworthy.
