If a vehicle entering the show ground via the livestock entrance is not displaying a vehicle pass there will be a charge for entering the show ground of £3 for Lorries/vehicle towing livestock/horse trailers and £5 per car. A FREE VEHICLE PASS WILL BE ISSUED TO ALL COMPETITORS ENTERING IN ADVANCE with a closing date of 27th July 2018. ALL CLASSES RUN UNDER BRITISH RIDING CLUB RULES

Hard hats must be worn by all mounted riders and must comply with the following hat standards:

PAS015 (1998 or 2011) & BSI KITE MARK – VGCI 01.040 (20014 –12) & BSI KITE MARK

ASTM F1163 (2004a or 04a onwards) & SEI MARK - SNELL E2001 & official SNELL Number AS/NZS 3838 (2006 onwards) & SAI LOBAL MARK.

No horse/pony to be left unattended tied to any vehicle. Dogs to be kept on leads
