RULES & REGULATIONS

Welsh Pony & Cob Society

The Welsh Pony and Cob Society offers Medals Section "A", "B", "C" and "D" for Stallions, Mares and Youngstock registered in the Society's Stud Book. Medals will be awarded to the Champion or Reserve Champion. Geldings are also eligible to receive a Society Medal.

- 1. In the case of an animal not registered at the time of entry at the Show at which a medal is competed for, application for registration must be made within one month of the date of the Show, otherwise the medal will not be awarded.
- 2. No animal shall be awarded more than one medal in any one year. Medals awarded at the Royal Welsh Show and those major Shows listed in the Panel of Judges which award medals are excepted from this rule (i.e. an animal can be awarded one gold, one silver and one bronze medal in any one season).
- 3. Medals will only be awarded to animals whose owners are members of the Welsh Pony and Cob Society and who have paid their subscriptions for the current year or are Life Members or who have submitted their names for membership and paid one annual subscription of Life membership composition. Owners who are not current members will be allowed 14 days after 1 August, 2016 to join the Society.
- 4. Medals will only be awarded when the classes are judged by a judge who is on the Panel of Judges of the Welsh Pony and Cob Society. (Copy available on application.)
- 5. Classification in the schedules of the Societies affiliated to the Welsh Pony and Cob Society should in all cases be in keeping with the Welsh Pony and Cob Society's rules in relation to height limits and weight of shoes.

SECTION "A"—Welsh Mountain Poinies, not exceeding 121.9cm.

SECTION "B"—Welsh Ponies, not exceeding 137.2cm.

SECTION "C"—Welsh Ponies (Cob Type), not exceeding 137.2cm

SECTION "D"—Welsh Cobs. No height limit.

"Welsh Part Bred": Minimum 121/2% Registered Welsh Blood.

- 6. All colts and stallions, 4 years old or over, must be in possession of a Society Licence of correctness (or acknowledged alternative) to be eligible for the award of a medal.
- 7. Half an inch will be allowed in height for shoeing.
- 8. Only animals entered in the Catalogue are able to compete for the W.P. & C.S. Bronze Medal classes (no substitutions will be allowed).

The Welsh Pony & Cob Gelding Incentive Scheme Millcroft Stud – Overall Gelding Champion and Reserve, to be competed for by the highest placed geldings from each appropriate class within Sections A, B, C & D, generously sponsored by the Millcroft Stud.

Running alongside this is the National High Point Junior Gelding of the Year, open to all geldings three years of age and under, shown in hand, with points gained throughout the year. Cups will be presented to Prize Winners.

RoR

Tattersalls RoR NOVICE Ridden Show Series Qualifier 2022

Thoroughbred mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, any height. Riders must be 15 years or over on the 1st January 2022. Horses should be ridden in a snaffle, pelham or simple double bridle with a plain cavasson noseband. Horses should be plaited.

The first three go forward to the Final at The Jockey Club RoR National Championships, Aintree in August 27th 2022. All entries MUST be have current RoR competition registration and have RACED in GB. The class will be run under the rules of RoR. All those entering horses and/or participating in the show agree to be bound by the Retraining of Racehorses Rules and Regulations from time to time in force.

Competitors must wear a safety/kite mark hard hat with a chinstrap. Racing injuries and blemishes are NOT ignored in this series.

To take part in this class, horses must NOT have won: a ridden open class under any affiliated showing society including (inc SEIB/HOYS, BSHA, SHB(GB) BSPS, BSPA, Tattersalls RoR Open Show Series Qualifier, TARRA Ridden, RoR AMATEUR Ridden Show Series Qualifier or any other open class except Tattersalls (TBA) RoR Challenge Show Series or other Working Hunter type classes. Unaffiliated Show wins are not taken into account. Horses WILL be ridden by the judge. Horses will be stripped for conformation.

Horses may remain in the Tattersalls RoR Novice Ridden Show Series (Formerly RoR Jockey Club Novice Show Series) classes until they have won (win) three Tattersalls RoR Novice Show Series Qualifiers. They are de-noviced on their third novice win or at midnight on the day they win an open class, whichever happens first. They are still eligible to compete in the Tattersalls RoR Novice Final at The Jockey Club RoR National Championships.

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS Qualifying or Life members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at the Three Counties Showground, Malvern on Sunday, 7th August 2022.

TGCA TOYS In Hand and Ridden Classes Affiliation No 22/3007/2/ULT

Breed classes are qualifiers for the Best of Breed Finals at the Traditional Gypsy Cob Association's (TGCA) National Breed Championship Show "TOYS". Classes are open to all traditional gypsy cobs. Competitors do not need to know the breeding of their cob, but they must meet breed standard to enter the class.

Stallions – All stallions (4 years and over) in order to enter any TGCA affiliated class **MUST** have be TGCA registered, have passed TGCA evaluations and their TGCA stallion

disc displayed on their bridle. Colts/Stallions three-year-old and over MUST be shown in a stallion bridle with a metal bit and chain lead.

Existing TGCA members that qualify **MUST** present their qualification card to the judge in the ring and **MUST** have already completed the cobs name and registration number prior to judge signing.

Non-members that qualify should receive a non-members qualification card from the judge in the ring and have 21 days to join the TGCA and register their horse to validate the qualification.

Quest for a Star Championship Inc Youngstock Quest for a Star – Traditional Gypsy Cobs 1st, 2nd and 3rd from the TGCA classes above may go forward to the Quest for a Star Championship as per below rule.

ONLY current TGCA members and horse/pony that is already TGCA registered can exhibit in this championship, if exhibit already has their Quest for a Star Qualification in particular section, they should be ask stand aside to allow members that have not yet qualified.

Membership card and Member's qualification card (specific to that exhibit) **must** be presented upon **entry into the ring**. The Champion and Reserve qualify for the Ultimate Star Championships at TOYS.

The Greatest Gelding Award – Traditional Gypsy Cobs – The award is aimed to encourage the showing of geldings, therefore creating a market for often unwanted colt foals and enabling the creation of a network of potential performance prospects to represent the best Traditional Gypsy Cob breed in the World at the highest level.

This Award should be given to the highest placed registered Traditional Gelding. The judge will award this within the classes/championship.

Shetland Ponies

- 1. Classes must be confined to SPS-BS registered ponies. Ponies **must be named on the entry form** and in the catalogue if one is produced. Society rosettes must only be given to ponies registered with the Society or to foals eligible for registration.
- 2. Three-year-old fillies with foals at foot may not be shown. All foals must be a minimum of three weeks old on the day of the Show.
- 3. IN ORDER TO ENTER A STALLION CLASS AT AN AFFILIATED SHOW, ENTIRE MALES AGED 4 YEARS OLD AND OVER MUST HAVE AN "S" NUMBER AND HAVE BEEN SUCCESSFULLY THROUGH EITHER THE SPS-BS STALLION ASSESSMENT PRIOR TO 2006 OR THE CURRENT SPSBS VOLUNTARY VETERINARY EXAMINATION. Ridden stallions MUST display a stallion bridle badge. In-hand entire males 2 years and over are advised to display a stallion bridle badge.
- 4. There must be no colts or entire males in Young Handlers classes. Children under 14 years old may not show colts (excluding foals) or entire males in In-hand classes. Children under 12 years old on the day of the show may not show entire males in ridden classes. In the interests of safety, hard hats must be worn by all handlers aged 14 years or under in In-hand classes. Exhibitors should not kneel but remain standing while in the ring. Hard hats must be worn by all exhibitors, irrespective of age, in ridden classes. Ridden and driven ponies must be 4 years old or over.

In ridden Classes, if a rider falls off at any time whilst in the ring, both pony and rider must leave the ring, rider dismounted, and take no further part.

TSR

(Qualifying classes are Part Breds; Mountain & Moorland; Mountain & Moorland Lead Rein; Mountain & Moorland Ridden; Rare & Foreign Breeds; Anglo/Part Bred Arabs; Hunter; Coloured Native/Traditional; Coloured Non-Native)

TSR NAF Five Star Showing Finals – This show is a qualifier for the 2022 TSR NAF Five Star Showing Finals. All In Hand & Ridden classes are qualifiers. You Do Not have to be a TSR member to qualify or enter a final. The Rider/Handler qualifies and can enter any horse/pony in any number of Finals! The 4 highest placed handlers/riders will qualify in each class. Competitors MUST have their qualification record sheet signed by judge/steward/secretary, sheets are available FREE from the TSR website. Full details at www.theshowingregister.co.uk

CHAPS

This Show is affiliated to The Coloured Horse & Pony Society (UK). Affiliation No. 22-159. Both owner and the rider/exhibitor need NOT be a member of CHAPS (UK) nor must the horse or pony be registered with CHAPS (UK) to compete. However in order to qualify both owner and rider/exhibitor need to be a current showing member and have a valid qualifier card. Members to apply in to CHAPS (UK) for appropriate qualifier card. The CHAPS (UK) Championship Show will be held on 11 - 13 August 2022

For full rulings and information on competition/qualification, please refer to the CHAPS (UK) Members' Handbook; or visit www.chapsuk.com. Only "coloured" horses and ponies (as defined in the current CHAPS UK Members' Handbook) may compete in these classes.

All stallions, 4 yrs old and over entering these classes must be graded with CHAPS (UK). All stallions must wear Stallion ID discs in the ring without exception.

Irish Draught Pure Bred Breeding Classes

The following Classes are affiliated to the Irish Draught Horse Society (GB) and only horses registered with or overstamped by the IDHSGB and in the correct ownership are eligible for entry. All Pure Bred Breeding and Youngstock in hand exhibits must be the progeny of a Graded Mare (Class 1, Class 2, RID (GB), AID or Supplementary Grade Up Register) and be by a Class 1, Class 2 or RID (GB) stallion on the Irish Draught Breed Register OR registered on the Irish Draught Sport Horse Register.

The owners of all Pure Bred Irish Draught Horses must be full members of the IDHS(GB). This rule does not apply to owners of Irish Draught Sport Horses. Registration numbers to be stated on the entry form, which will be sent to the IDHSGB prior to the show to confirm eligibility.

The two highest placed pure-breds from each age group (that have not already qualified) in Classes 171-173 - yearlings, two year olds and three year olds - eligible for Class 1 in the Irish Draught Breed Register by a Class 1, Class 2 or RID (GB) sire, out of a graded dam or, if one or both have already qualified, the horse next in line in each age group, will qualify to go forward to their respective final, which will be held at the IDHS (GB) Annual Breed Show on 13 and 14 August 2022 at Onley Equestrian Centre, Onley Grounds Farm, Willoughby, Rugby, Warwickshire CV23 8AJ.

Each qualifier will receive a card. Qualifiers are required to complete an online form at www.idhsgb.org.uk to inform the IDHS (GB) that they have qualified for the final. In the final, there will be three preliminary classes with the two highest placed semi-finalists from each class going forward to the Championship where the Champion will receive £500 and the Reserve Champion £150.

The IDHS (GB) £2000 Ridden Challenge

This show is a qualifier for the Irish Draught Horse Society (GB) £2,000 Ridden Challenge. The highest placed horse (not already qualified) from class 175 and class 180 that is registered or eligible for registration on the Irish Draught or Irish Draught Sport Horse Register, with a minimum of 25% proven Irish Draught breeding, will qualify for the final of the IDHS (GB) £2,000 Ridden Challenge. Horses need not be registered with the Irish Draught Horse Society (GB) to qualify but must be on the IDHS (GB) Registers by the time of the Championship, which will be held at the IDHS (GB) Annual Breed Show on 13th and 14th August 2022 at Onley Equestrian Centre, Onley Grounds Farm, Willoughby, Rugby, Warwickshire CV23 8AJ.

In the final, the Champion will be awarded £1,000 prize money and a trophy. The Reserve Champion will be awarded £500, and 3rd to 7th inclusive will be awarded £100 each. In addition the highest placed Purebred Irish Draught will receive a trophy and £100, and the highest placed Sport Horse will receive a trophy and £50.

Exercise Vehicles

Lamps need not be carried. Judging will include general cleanliness, safety of turnout, correct fitting of harness and vehicle suitability.
