



IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ALL EXHIBITORS

The safety of the public at agricultural shows has always been a much concern to organisers but has now become a matter of paramount importance in relation to Public Liability and the Health & Safety at Work Act. The show is no exception and presents many difficult problems because of its size in terms of people and livestock at the show. In order to meet legal and insurance requirements, it has been necessary to introduce arrangements to segregate as far as possible, the general public from livestock. The Society has appointed a team of Safety Stewards to supervise the implementation of these measures which will control the movement of people and livestock to and from different areas of the showground.

THE DIRECTIONS OF THE STEWARDS OF SAFETY MUST BE FOLLOWED AT ALL TIMES.

It is in your own interest to comply with all the instructions and to observe the procedures laid down and the Society would appreciate your full co-operation in this. However, should any exhibitor refuse to comply with the instructions of the Safety Stewards the Society will have no alternative but to immediately remove from the show ground the exhibitor's entries and all fees paid or prizes won will be forfeited. This condition will be strictly enforced and no appeal will be entertained. Please adhere to the Society's rules which are printed on page eight of the show schedule. The Society's Safety Policy can be found in the rear of the show schedule and the plan of the show ground which is printed on the inside cover of the show schedule. Please familiarise yourself with the safety policy and the positions of the fire extinguishers, medical services and exit points on the show ground.

Horse Exhibitor's numbers are to be collected from the Secretary's office on the morning of show day. Cattle Exhibitor Numbers will be available from the Cattle Stewards trailer and the Sheep, Goats and Pigs numbers will be available in the Sheep Stewards Trailer.

CATTLE EXHIBITORS:

You must ensure that you have handed all your animal passports to the Bio-Security Officials at the entrance into the designated area (marked 14 on the show ground plan). **There will be a Cattle Parade, with all rosette winners expected to take part.**

PIG EXHIBITORS:

Please ensure that you have completed the movement forms electronically. Please use the pens allocated to you.

SHEEP & GOAT EXHIBITORS:

Please ensure that you have completed the movement forms, listing each individual tag number and not just the UK Number. Please hand them all in to the Bio-Security Officials at the entrance into the designated area (marked 14 on show ground plan). Please also complete your AML1 form in readiness for your return journey in advance to avoid long delays in leaving the show ground and be sure to collect them before you leave. Please use the pens allocated to you.

HORSES: Please be sure to have your Horse Passports on you if asked to produce them. One handler per exhibit only will be allowed into the horse walkway.

Do not stand in the animal walk way.
